Commonly Confused Words: Historic vs. Historical

Historic and *historical* sound a little alike. Both are adjectives, but their meanings are different.

Historic is an adjective meaning *important in history*.

Example 1: The battlefield was an **historic** site.

Historical is an adjective meaning *based on the past or about past events*.

Example 1: The pioneer village had people in **historical** costumes.

The difference is that **historic** means something of that is important, as opposed to **historical**, which means anything relating to the past. Anything involved with the past is **historical**, but only those things that are significant are called **historic**.
