Dictionary Came: Definitions

Team rules: Cut out each of the word cards and shuffle. Divide students into teams. Provide a dictionary for each team. Each student on the team takes a turn with the dictionary. Display a word card. Each team looks up the word in the dictionary, writes the first meaning (or the first sentence of the meaning) on a piece of paper, and holds it up. First team with the correct answer wins a point. First team to win five points wins the game.

Timed game rules (for one or two students): Cut out each of the word cards and shuffle. Provide a dictionary for each student. Display a word card. Each student looks up the word in the dictionary, writes the first meaning on a piece of paper, and holds it up. Use a stopwatch to time each student's response. Student with the fastest response time wins, or for a single student, repeat the game at a later date to improve the time.
