

Passing the Puck: Direct Objects in Sentences

Part 1

A direct object is a noun or pronoun that receives the action of a verb. Put another way, the verb acts upon the direct object.

Example 1: Jack passed the puck.

Jack is the subject of the sentence. *Passed* is the verb, and it is an action verb. The noun that receives the action *passed* is the direct object. In this sentence, *puck* is the direct object. A simple test to find the direct object is to ask "what?" or "whom?" If the answer to the question is a noun or pronoun, then it is usually a direct object.

Question: Jack passed the what? Answer: puck

The answer to the question is *puck* which is a noun and the direct object.
