



Subject and Predicate Match Game

Cut out all the cards and shuffle. Turn all the cards face down on a table. The student selects two cards. If the cards make a complete sentence, the student can remove the cards. If the two cards do not make a complete sentence, the cards are turned face down again. Once all the cards are removed, the game is over. May be played alone or in student pairs. If two students play, the student with the most complete sentences wins.
