Using Passive Voice to Find a Direct Object

A direct object is a noun or pronoun that receives the action of a verb. Put another way, the verb acts upon the direct object.

Example 1: My mother drove the car.

In the example the car receives the action from the verb *drove*. The direct object is *car*.

Passive voice is a way to construct a sentence where the direct object is written as the subject of the sentence. The car was driven by my mother.

The meaning is the same, but Example 1 is active voice, where the subject of the sentence is performing the action. Example 2 is passive voice, where the subject, formerly the direct object, is not performing any action. Changing a sentence to passive voice is a way to easily find the direct object in a sentence.
