## Superlative Adjectives: Words That End in Y


Superlative adjectives are used to compare three or more things.

**Example 1:** He took the **largest** cupcake on the tray

*Largest* is the superlative adjective.

Many superlative adjectives are formed by adding *-st* or *-est* to the adjective. However sometimes the adjective ends in *y*. Usually you change the *y* to *i* and add *-est*.


