Past Continuous

The past continuous verb tense, sometimes called the past progressive, is the present participle form of a verb used with the past tense form of *to be*.

Past tense: I sang.

Past continuous tense: I was singing.

The past continuous tense is used for showing an action that was ongoing or happening continually in the past. It sometimes shows an interruption in action.

Example 1: The cats were sleeping on the bed.

Example 2: She was sweeping the porch when the storm came in.
