Example 2: The big dog was a common sight on the town's streets.

Example 3: When everyone is quiet, the archer will sight her target.

Site is a noun meaning a location or a website on the Internet.

Example 1: This was the site where the battle was fought.

Example 2: The club made a page on a social networking site.
