Commonly Confused Words: Later vs. Latter

Later and *latter* sound a little alike, but their meanings are different.

Later is used as a comparative adjective meaning “more late.” It is also used as an adverb meaning afterward or at a past time.

Example 1: We will leave **later** than Jose.

Example 2: I'll talk to you **later**.



Latter is an adjective meaning the last or second of two things. It also means at the end or near the end.
