

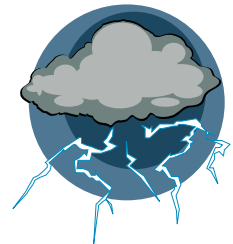
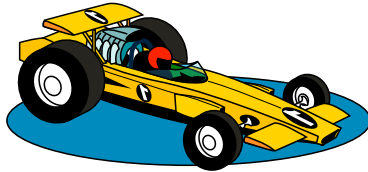

Onomatopoeia is the use of a word or phrase that imitates the sound of something.

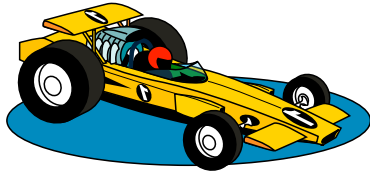

Actual answers will vary. Examples of correct answers:



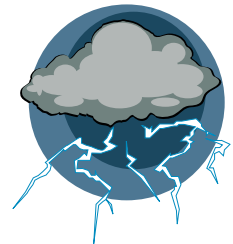
