

# Latin and Greek Prefixes: Anti- and Deci-

any prefixes we use in English originally come from Greek or Latin words. The prefix anti-/ant- is from a Greek word meaning "opposite" or "against." The prefix deci-/deca-/decim- is from a Latin word and a Greek word meaning "ten." If you understand what the prefix means, it will help you understand the meaning of the whole word. For example, the root bacterial means "related to bacteria." Combine anti- with bacterial, and it becomes the word antibacterial. Based on its original meaning, antibacterial means "against bacteria" or something that kills bacteria.


