

Latin and Greek Prefixes: Semi- and Mille-/Milli-

Many prefixes we use in English originally come from Greek or Latin words. The prefix *semi-* is from a Latin word meaning “half” or “part.” The prefix *mille-/milli-* is from a Latin word meaning “one thousand.” If you understand what the prefix means, it will help you understand the meaning of the whole word. For example, the root *second* means “a 60th of a minute.” Combine *milli-* with *second*, and it becomes the word *millisecond*. Based on its original meaning, *millisecond* means “one thousand of a 60th of a minute” or 1000th of a second.
