	1. All of my sentences begin with capital letters and end with an appropriate punctuation mark.
	2. All of my sentences are complete sentences (no fragments or run-ons).
	3. All of my sentences are arranged in an order that makes sense to form well-organized paragraphs. (I have clear topic sentences and supporting detail sentences.)
	4. Each of my paragraphs addresses only one topic.
	5. I capitalized the names of people, places, titles, and specific things.
	6. I used a dictionary or other reference to check my spelling.
	7. I used commas to separate words and phrases correctly.
	8. I used apostrophes correctly to form contractions or show possession.
	9. I used quotation marks around the direct words of speakers, or around direct quotes used as evidence.
\	10. I used a thesaurus or other reference to replace over-used words with words that add more interest to my writing.
