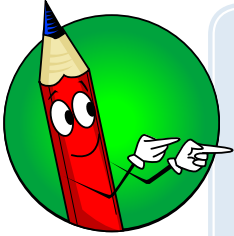


Spelling Rules Exceptions for ED and ING: No ED or ING!

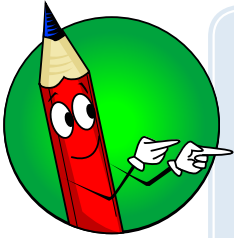
