Example:

<u>In other words</u>, a longer school day may provide more opportunities instead of fewer.

as an illustration specifically

by all means surely

certainly that is to say

e.g., (for example) to clarify

especially to demonstrate

for example to explain

for instance to illustrate

i.e., (that is) to put it another way

importantly to repeat
